## NOTICE OF RACE

---

### 1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2 [DP] All competitors shall wear a PFD at all times while on the water, other than brief periods while adding or removing clothing, or below deck. The 'Y' flag will not be flown. This changes RRS 40 and the preamble to Part 4.
- 1.3 RRS 48.2 is deleted.
- 1.4 US Sailing Prescriptions 63.2 and 63.4 are deleted.

### 2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The regatta is open to all Mercury boats whose skipper is a member in good standing of the Mercury Class Yacht Racing Association.
- 2.2 Eligible boats may enter by submitting the entry form and paying the entry fee online [www.stfyc.com](http://www.stfyc.com), on or before Saturday 9/22/18 by 0900. An entry is not considered complete until the entry fee has been paid. All entry fees are non-refundable.

### 3 FEES

The entry fee is \$20.

### 6 RACING AREA

The intended race area will be set on the San Francisco City Front utilizing fixed and temporary inflatable marks.

### 7 SCORING

- 7.1 One race is required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 7.2 A boat's series score shall be the total of her race scores.

### 8 PRIZES

The Joe Logan Perpetual Trophy will be awarded to the overall winner.

Sailing is an activity that has an inherent risk of damage and injury. Competitors in this race participate entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The race organizers (OA, Ratings Authority, Race Committee, Protest Committee, host club, sponsors, or any other organization or official) will not be responsible for damage to any boat or other property or the injury to any competitor, including death, sustained as a result of participation in this race. By participating in this race, each competitor agrees to release the race organizers from any and all liability associated with such competitor's participation in this event to the fullest extent permitted by law.
