
Going into the last race, Davis was leading with 22; Chris Gould with 24, Dick Clark with 27, Steve Gould with 28 1/2. Anderson and Mettier with 39 each and Huggins with 39 1/2. This race was also the first time we would be racing for the John Koenig Perpetual Trophy—the winner of the last race of the Nationals.

This was another 10-12 mile gold cup into almost slack water. Still the best course was on the shore but 150 wind shifts could not be ignored. Steve Gould and Huggins were off fast, Davis and Chris Gould were buried and because Chris Gould would sail so well that he and Davis had a great game of chase with Dick Clark right in there. At the first weather mark it was S. Gould, Huggins, C. Gould, Mettier, Grether, Blucher, Lindley, Davis, Hall and others. At the wing and leeward marks the first three were holding, but Grether had Davis followed by Blucher and Hall. At the weather mark it was S. Gould, Huggins, C. Gould going around together, Davis, D. Clark and Grether. The wind was light on the run and Huggins led at the leeward mark, C. Gould, S. Gould, Davis all very close, C. Gould went outside, Davis the middle and then to the shore in which he got S. Gould. Then a nice lift come in for the boats on the shore and Huggins followed by Davis were on the way to the finish-Chris Gould tacked to the line from the outside, but was sailing into a header-Huggins had it at the finish and the John Koenig Trophy, and three daily first's. C. Gould crossed in front of Davis. Grether by sailing in clean air came in a very close fourth, Blucher got the fifth, S. Gould, sixth, Mettier, seventh, D. Clark eight, Hall was ninth and Ted Lindley was tenth.

The final standings were: Davis 25, C. Gould 25, S. Gould 34 1/2, D. Clark 34, and Dave Huggins 40 1/4.


