#### 1200 WARNING SIGNAL FOR FIRST RACE EACH DAY

**Rules:** Races will be conducted under the *Racing Rules of Sailing* (2017-2020), the U.S. Sailing Prescriptions, and the Rules of the Mercury Class Yacht Racing Association, the Sailing Instructions and any properly posted notices and announcements.

**Registration:** Participants may register by mail or at the MPYC Clubhouse before 1030 on November 7 or before 1030 on any subsequent race day. Like most clubs, MPYC has been financially impacted by COVID-19: the Club cannot afford to host this series without at least 10 entries. Please let Jack McAleer know (see contact info below) as soon as possible if you plan to register. IF 10 FIRM COMMITMENTS ARE NOT RECEIVED BY WEDNESDAY, OCTOBER 28, THE SERIES WILL BE CANCELLED.

**Entry Fee:** \$80, payable in advance by mail or in person prior to racing. (US Sailing members may deduct \$5.) Make checks payable to Monterey Peninsula Yacht Club.

**COVID-19 Restrictions:** Face masks are required at all times while on MPYC premises. There will be no Competitors Meetings, and the clubhouse is closed except for the bathrooms. Please exercise social distancing on the Club docks and deck.

**Scoring:** The Low Point Scoring System shall be used with 12 races scheduled. Yachts may discard their worst scores as follows: If four or more races are completed, then each yacht may discard her worst score. If eight or more races are completed, then each yacht may discard her two worst scores. If twelve races are completed, then each yacht may discard her three worst scores.

**Launching:** Hoisting is included with entry; only authorized people may operate the hoist. Please plan on leaving the dock no later than 1115, as the Junior Laser practice begins at noon.
